

TERMS AND CONDITIONS Summer Camp 2019

During this exciting five-day creative camp, your child will focus on building and improving his or her language and artistic skills while learning about and practising art.

Our native-speaker educators will engage the children in discussions and activities through gallery and studio explorations.

Campers will explore works of art visiting 3 different museums each week and learning about new approaches and art techniques. Moreover they are going to spend about 20hrs of instructed art lessons in the classroom where they will develop a personal artistic style through experimenting with a variety of mediums including painting and collage.

During the entire week the children will be invited to express their ideas and emotions in English.

They will also have some free time for games and walks in the open air.

-Two teachers will be with the children all the time: one native English speaker and one speaking Italian, plus a third educator during the outings.

-The language spoken during camp will be English.

- The group will be of maximum 15 children.
