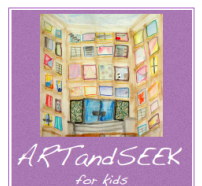
On our open-air visit, children will see how these mural makers have been inspired by history, politics and pop culture to make connections with past and present, life and death, legend and reality.
